O'Donnell & Naccarato projects earn Pennsylvania Parking Association awards.

Philadelphia, PA — The Pennsylvania Parking Association (PPA) has given an Award of Excellence to Saint Joseph's University Hawks' Landing Parking Garage and an Award of Merit to the Lehigh Valley Hospital and Health Network Parking structure.

O'Donnell & Naccarato, a Philadelphia-based consulting structural engineering, parking consulting and project management firm, served as structural engineer on both projects, as well as project manager and parking consultant on the Hawks' Landing garage.

Hawks' Landing earned an award in the "New Design, Less than 450 Spaces" division. The Lehigh Valley Hospital project earned its award in the "New Design 450 – 1,000 Spaces" division.

"When we formed our parking division nearly 20 years ago, we knew that we were capable of creating buildings that were more than simply parking structures," says Nick Cinalli, president and CEO, O'Donnell & Naccarato.

Hawks' Landing is a 210,000 SF, six-story parking structure that provides 442 campus parking spaces. It incorporates Gothic elements, archways and natural stone facades in keeping with the historic themes of the existing university buildings. The structure was designed to be a gateway to the school's campus, and provides a first impression to the University that is both scholarly and contemporary.

Hawks' Landing provides more than 18,000 SF of first floor retail spaces, including the newly relocated University Bookstore and the Cosi restaurant.

The Lehigh Valley Hospital parking structure is, in fact, two, two-level, 180,000 SF garages that flank the main entrance boulevard leading to the hospital. The new garages offer visitors a total of 900 spaces of self- and valet parking, and house nearly 75% more cars than the surface lots they replaced.

The garages' unique design takes advantage of the rolling terrain's gentle east-west slope. With single-width bays, the low-profile structures are fitted into the landscape and maintain an unobstructed sightline for the hospital.
