O'Donnell & Naccarato's Jonathan Brazier to speak at Autodesk University 2009

(PHILADELPHIA, PA) — From a pool of more than 2,000 submissions, Jonathan Brazier, O'Donnell & Naccarato's Director of Production Technology has been selected to lead a class at Autodesk University 2009 being held in Las Vegas in early December.

Mr. Brazier will be leading a 90-minute lab entitled "Yes! You Can Document Your Autodesk® Revit® Structure Model." During this session, Mr. Brazier will instruct attendees on how to use Revit Structure's tools and components to effectively create clear, accurate "live" sections, details, 3D views and schedules. The session will also provide instruction on creating typical details in Revit using the AutoCAD details currently in every company's library.

He has also been an Autodesk® Beta tester for more than 5 years.
